## Dates for Jr. High Intensive



Registration for 2010-2011 classes will begin in April. Our Intensive classes begin this Spring 2010 and we are making the dates known to help families manage schedules and all the activities that need to be accommodated. The following dates are for the Spring and Summer Intensive classes. Students must be present everyday during the Spring or Summer sessions and also attend eleven Sunday classes from September through April. There is also the option of coming to one of the weekly classes held Monday and Wednesday 6:15 to 7:30pm September through April.

- Spring Session - held 5 consecutive Mondays April 26, May 3, 10 17 and 24, 2010 from 4:00 to 6:15pm plus eleven Sundays. (This option would not be suitable for any student in a Spring sports program.)
- June Intensive - one week June 21 thru 25 from 1:30-3:45pm and eleven Sundays.
- July Intensive - one week July 26 thru July 30 from 9:30-11:45am and eleven Sundays.

Please consider which session is best suited to your student and his/her activities. Registration is accepted on a first come, first served basis and is restricted by class size and availability of catechists. If you have any questions please call the R.E. office at 847-272-3086.

Supper will be a small, simple meal to show our solidarity with the poor. There will be a free-will offering for the victims of the earthquake in Haiti. At 7:00pm we will gather in church to pray the Stations of the Cross in a format geared to families. Lent is a time of reflection, a time to give not just give something up. A time to examine all that is important and to remember our Lord, Who is all important. This is an opportunity for you and your family to gather with friends and classmates to share this custom of Lent. Please plan to join us, but if you can not, Stations of the Cross will be held every Friday night during Lent if you can attend another evening or more than once!
